

Ergonomics Flyer Assignment

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Time to design a flyer for promoting ergonomics to the KCI community! You will use the design tool [Canva.com](https://www.canva.com) to design your flyer and will submit it to Mr. Dupuis in D2L.

Design Criteria

Your flyer will be created on Canva on a standard letter sized canvas (8.5" x 11").

In your design, you **must** include:

- ✓ A title
- ✓ A quote, phrase, or informative sentence about ergonomics
- ✓ At least one (1) of the elements of design (symmetry, balance, contrast, and consistency)
- ✓ At least one (1) image of an ergonomic item (chair, keyboard, mouse, etc.)
- ✓ Include at least one (1) topic related to ergonomics (posture, furniture, workspace, etc.)
- ✓ Include at least one tip/recommendation to the KCI community on how they can improve the ergonomics of their workspaces.
- ✓ Include a link to an article about ergonomics so that people can learn more after reading the flyer.

You may use a template on Canva for your flyer, or you may also use a blank canvas and start from scratch.

Design Concepts

On a *separate document*, include a one (1) paragraph explanation of why you designed your article the way you did and how you included on of the elements of design in your flyer.
